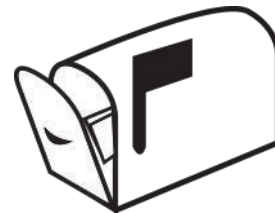

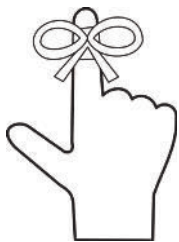
From the Director's Chair

You can make such a big difference by sharing a few hours of your time. Several opportunities are available in the greater Wausau area. You pick the date and time.

It's More Than a RIDE



Consider being a driver for your elderly neighbors. Do you have a car, driver's license and insurance? You do?! Then you can be a volunteer driver!

Please share an hour of your time to help an elderly neighbor to go grocery shopping, pick up medications or go to a medical appointment. It takes about an hour to provide some friendship and much needed transportation.



Please Help a Senior with Light Housekeeping

Several elderly neighbors in Wausau are in need of some assistance with mopping kitchen and bathroom floors, vacuuming and dusting. This is something that they are just not able to do any more. One Care-Receiver said, **“Washing the floor isn't the problem, it's just the getting up that presents a huge challenge!”**

The time commitment is approximately 1 hour every 4-6 weeks. This could be an on-going assignment or just one time. The requests are for assistance once every 4 to 6 weeks.
